4. JPT Idea's

■ Utilization

- ✓ To be reference when you develop plans for DRR and Urban Planning (local level)
 - > ex. Annual plan, budget plan, capacity development plan, etc.
- ✓ To be reference when you develop national policy and strategy (national level)
- ✓ To be monitoring tool for DRR activities or status of local governments (national level)

■ Feasibility

- ✓ National Government (DMO) awards excellent local governments.
- ✓ Policy/Regulation/Guideline specify usage of checklist
- ✓ ACDM requests each AMS to report monitoring results by using checklists (ex: ASEAN Day for Disaster Management)
